

#### GENDER SENSITIZATION POLICY

'Gender' in this policy refers to those behaviours and attitudes which are culturally accepted as appropriate ways of being a woman (femininity) and ways of being man (masculinity). The sex of a person is biologically determined, whereas ways of being a man or women are learned, they are a social construct— they are constructed, reinforced, maintained, and reconstructed over time through social and cultural practices.

"Gender Sensitization" refers to teaching of gender sensitivity and encouragement of behaviour modification through raising awareness of gender equality concerns. Gender sensitization is the raising sensitization of gender equality concerns through examining their personal attitudes and beliefs and questioning the realities of both sexes. It is important as both feel valued in society and lead a dignified life.

Since its inception, Biyani Girls College has focused on women empowerment through various initiatives and actions for creating a safe, secure and healthy atmosphere in the campus for their holistic development by providing world class education.

College is committed to gender sensitization by developing a sustainable and inclusive environment by empowering the women and girls so that they can contribute to the development of the community.

The following are the areas of concern-

- Fostering gender equality in all aspects of college life and throughout the college community for which Equal Opportunity Centre has been established in the college.
